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Pulpwood Production in the Lake States, 1994

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ABSTRACT.—Pulpwood production in the Lake States increased from 9.4 million cords in 1993 to 9.7 million in 1994. Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin pulpwood production is shown by county and species group.

KEY WORDS: Residue, roundwood, whole tree chips, Minnesota, Michigan, Wisconsin.

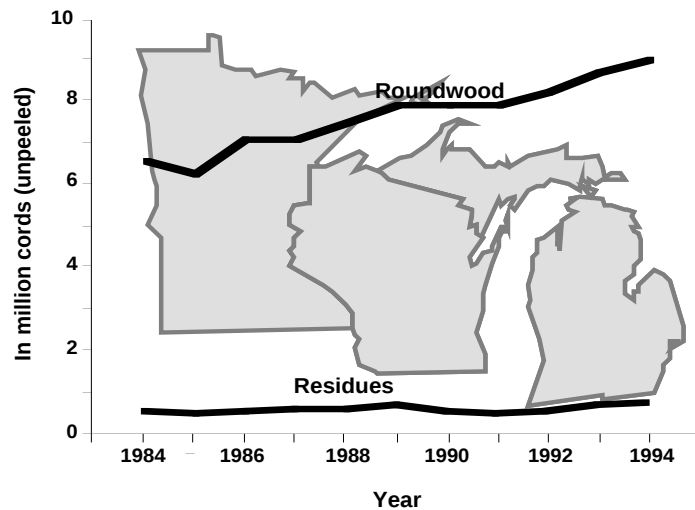


Figure 1.—Pulpwood production, Lake States, 1984-1994.

Pulpwood production² in the Lake States—Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin—increased to 9.7 million cords in 1994 from 9.4 million cords in 1993³. Wisconsin produced 3.5 million cords, Michigan produced 3.3 million cords, and Minnesota produced 3.0 million cords in 1994 (table 1). Ninety-two percent of the pulpwood produced came from roundwood (including chips from roundwood); the remainder came from mill residues such as slabs, edgings, veneer cores, and chips from these materials (fig. 1).

ROUNDWOOD

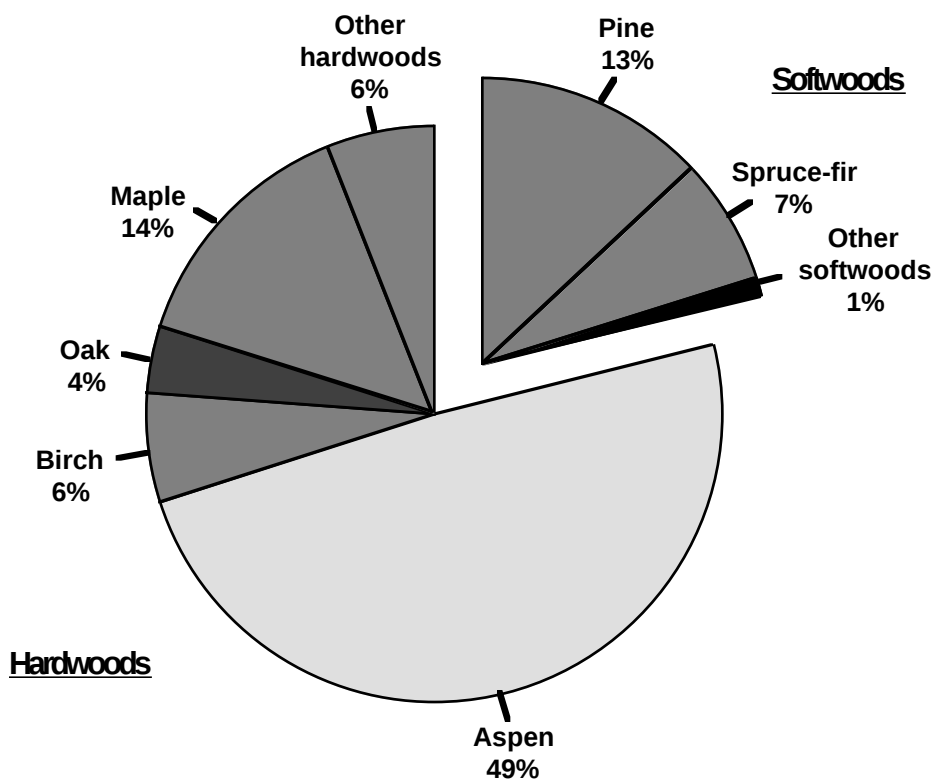


Figure 2.—Distribution of roundwood production by major species group, Lake States, 1994.

Roundwood production totaled 9.0 million cords and was equally distributed among the three Lake States. Seventy-eight percent of the harvested species were hardwoods. Aspen accounted for 49 percent of the total production (4.4 million cords). The other major species groups were maple (1.3 million cords), pine (1.2 million cords), spruce-fir (0.6 million cords), and birch (0.6 million cords) (fig. 2).

Counties harvesting more than 150 thousand cords each were Iron, Marquette, and Ontonagon in Michigan; Beltrami, Cass, Itasca, Koochiching, and St. Louis in Minnesota; and Bayfield, Douglas, Iron, Marinette, and Oneida in Wisconsin. These 12 counties contributed 36 percent of the pulpwood production from roundwood in the Lake States in 1994.

In 1994, whole tree chips (WTC) supplied 679 thousand cords or 8 percent of the roundwood production, a 13-percent increase over 1993. Michigan was the major WTC producer with 448 thousand cords, followed by Minnesota with 127 thousand cords, and Wisconsin with 105 thousand cords.

MILL RESIDUES

Pulpwood production from mill residues amounted to 756 thousand cords in 1994, a 10-percent increase over 1993. Mill residue production increased by 53 percent in Minnesota, increased by only 4 percent in Wisconsin, and decreased by 2 percent in Michigan. Production from softwood and hardwood residues by State was:
