PULPWOOD PRODUCTION IN THE LAKE STATES BY COUNTY, 1974

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ABSTRACT.—This 29th annual report shows 1974 pulpwood production by county and species group in Michigan, Minnesota, and Wisconsin. Production in these three Lake States climbed to 5.5 million cords in 1974 from 4.7 million cords in 1973.

Lake States pulpwood production rose to 5.47 million cords in 1974 from 4.72 million cords in 1973 (table 1). Production climbed 294,000 cords in Wisconsin, 257,000 cords in Michigan, and 201,000 cords in Minnesota.

About 91 out of every 100 cords were harvested by Lake States loggers; the remainder was mill residue, such as slabs, edgings, veneer cores, and chips from these materials.

Most (93 percent) of the increase in output was roundwood or chips from roundwood. All species groups, except spruce, contributed to the larger harvest. Principal increases were in aspen (+271,000 cords), pine (+149,000 cords), and the "miscellaneous hardwoods"¹ (+165,000 cords).

For the first time, oak and maple are shown separately in the table. Both are important pulpwood species groups that have been growing in use. Together they account for 11 percent of the 1974 Lake States pulpwood output.

Major production gains occurred in all northern areas of the Lake States and in central Wisconsin. Top-yielding counties were Marquette, Iron, and Dickinson in Michigan; St. Louis, Koochiching, and Itasca in Minnesota; and Oneida, Price, and Lincoln in Wisconsin.

Pulpmills using Lake States timber in 1974 reported their pulpwood receipts by State, county, and species groups. Their cooperation is gratefully acknowledged. Thanks are also due to Al Boelter, Michigan Department of Natural Resources, for collecting the data from pulpmills in Michigan.
