1974 OREGON TIMBER HARVEST

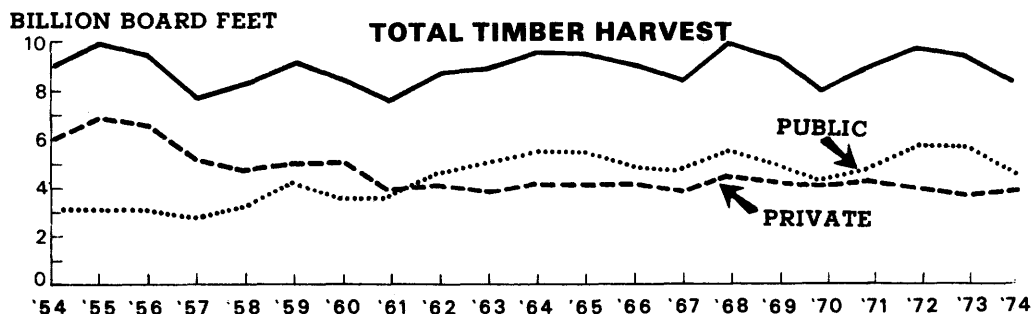

The 1974 Oregon timber harvest of 8.36 billion board feet was 9.2 percent, or 0.84 billion board feet, below the 1973 harvest. (The data for 1973 were adjusted to reflect the change in reporting of harvest on Bureau of Land Management lands; see footnote 3 of table.) While the harvest in western Oregon decreased 14.7 percent, eastern Oregon cut increased 11.5 percent.

Timber harvest on all public lands decreased 18.9 percent, or 1.06 billion board feet, compared with 1973. Nearly all the decrease was in western Oregon where the harvest was down 23.6 percent, while the harvest in eastern Oregon decreased only 4.6 percent. Total harvest on National Forests decreased 17.5 percent and on Bureau of Land Management lands, 23.5 percent.

Total harvest on private lands increased 5.9 percent or 212 million board feet above the 1973 mark. In western Oregon, cut on forest industry lands increased 6.0 percent, or 150 million board feet, but decreased on other private lands 39.9 percent or 225 million board feet. On the east side, harvest increased on forest industry and other private lands, respectively, 31.6 percent (147 million board feet) and 150 percent (140 million board feet).
