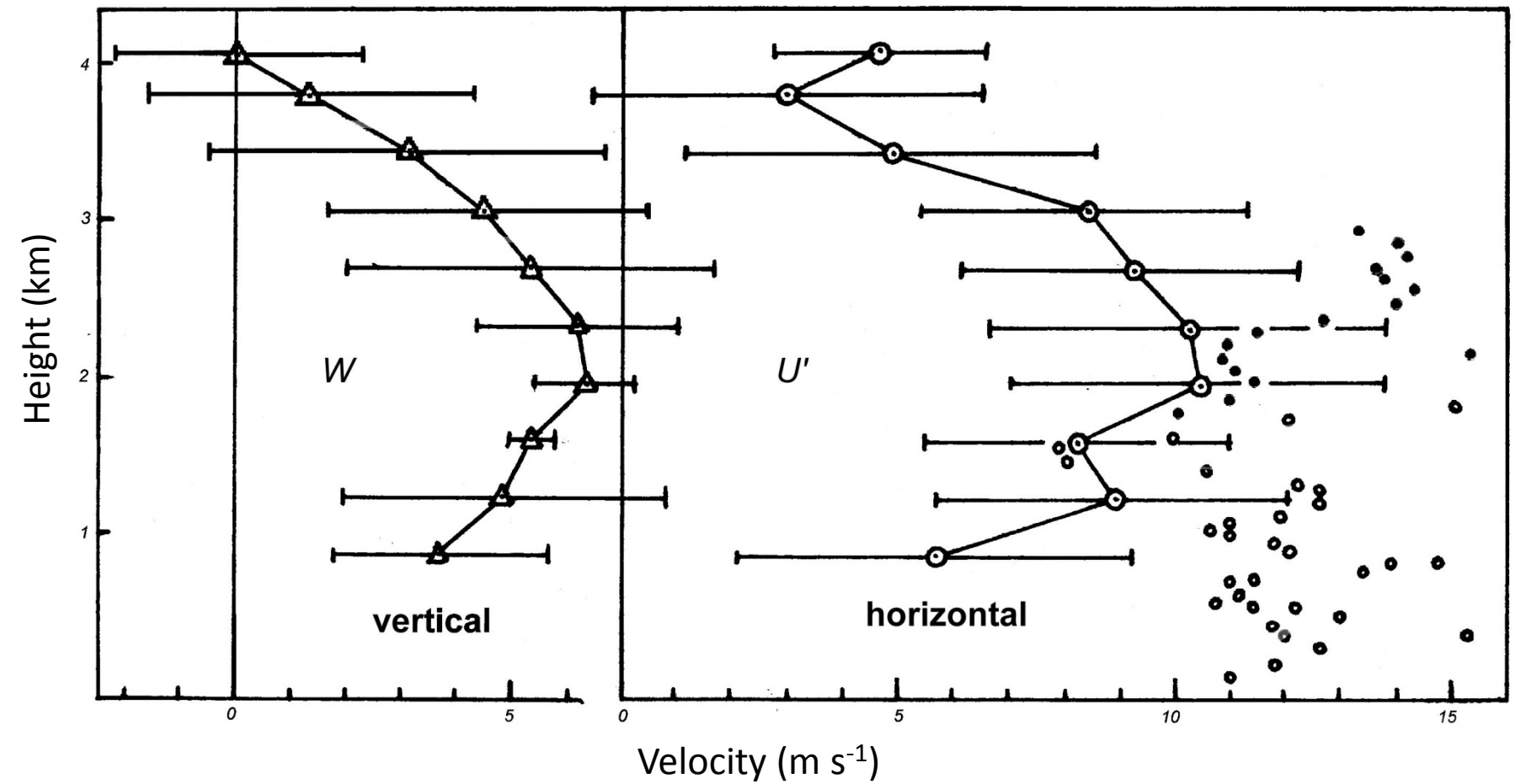

Equipment

- 3 Canon EOS-5D Mark 3's with GPS
- 2 Canon EOS-7D's
- 5 Canon HFR300 video cameras

Deployment

- Specific locations based on burn unit and weather conditions
- Several close-in cameras, at least one remote camera
- Still and video cameras co-located on tripods

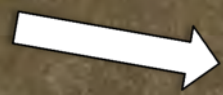

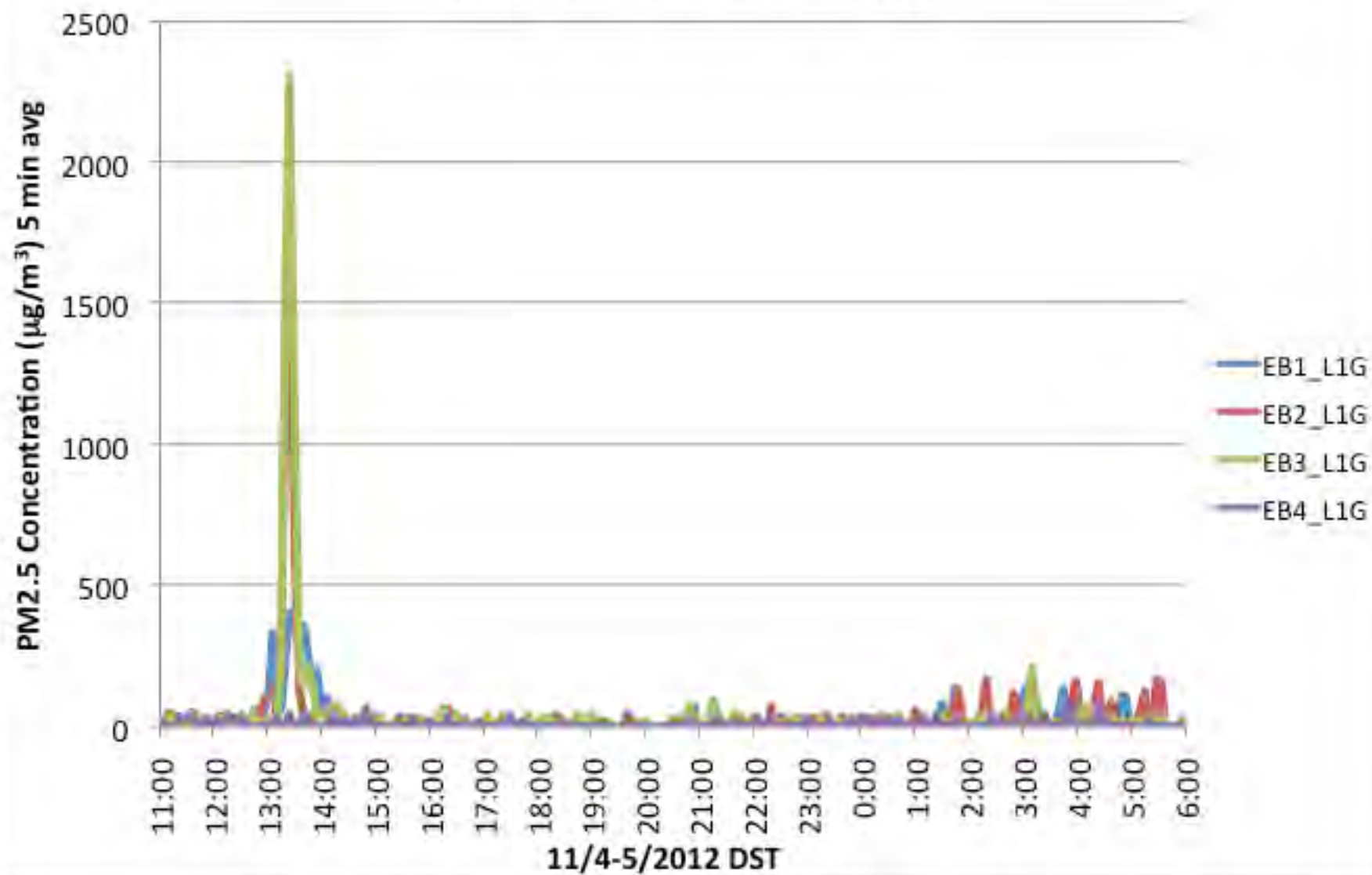

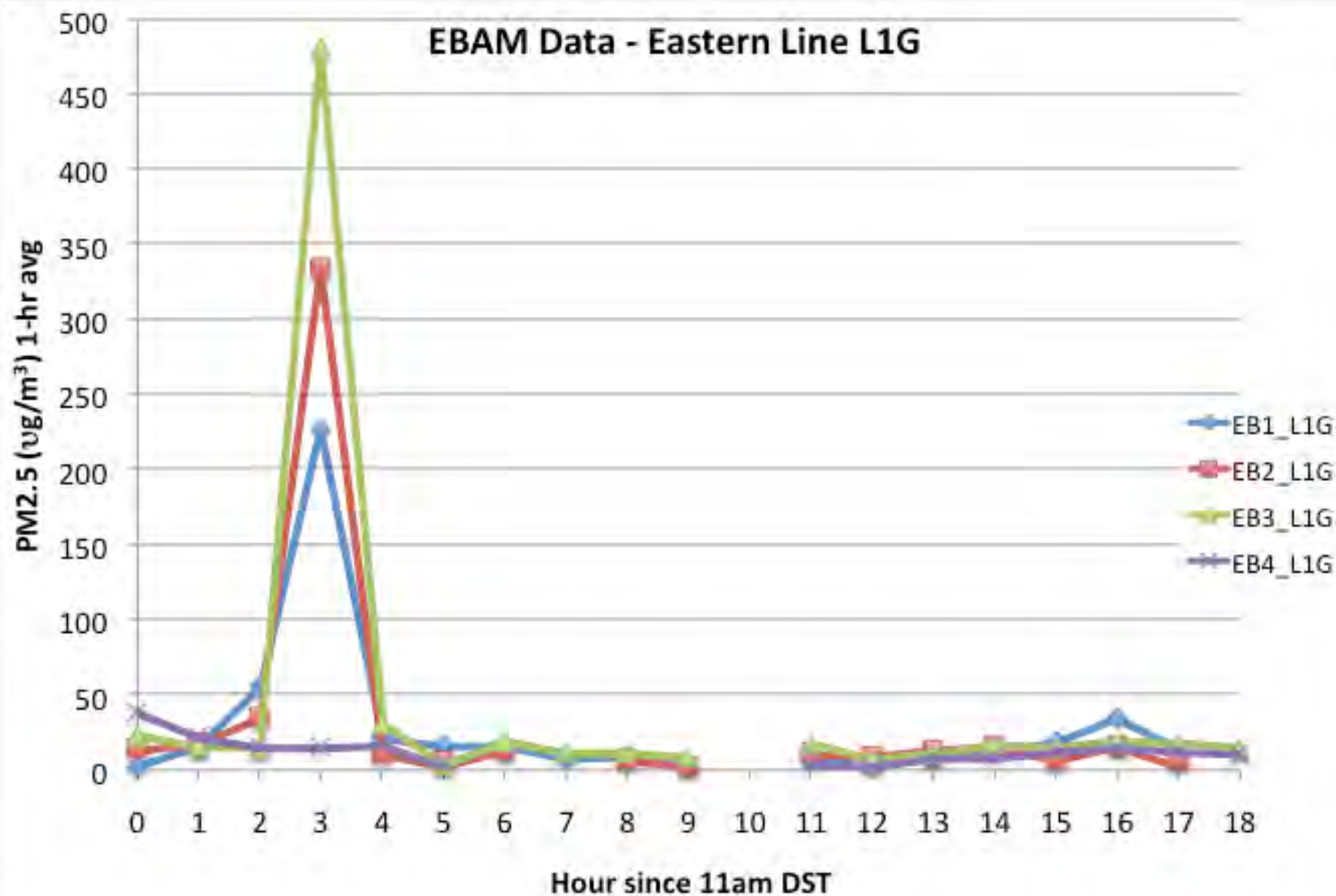

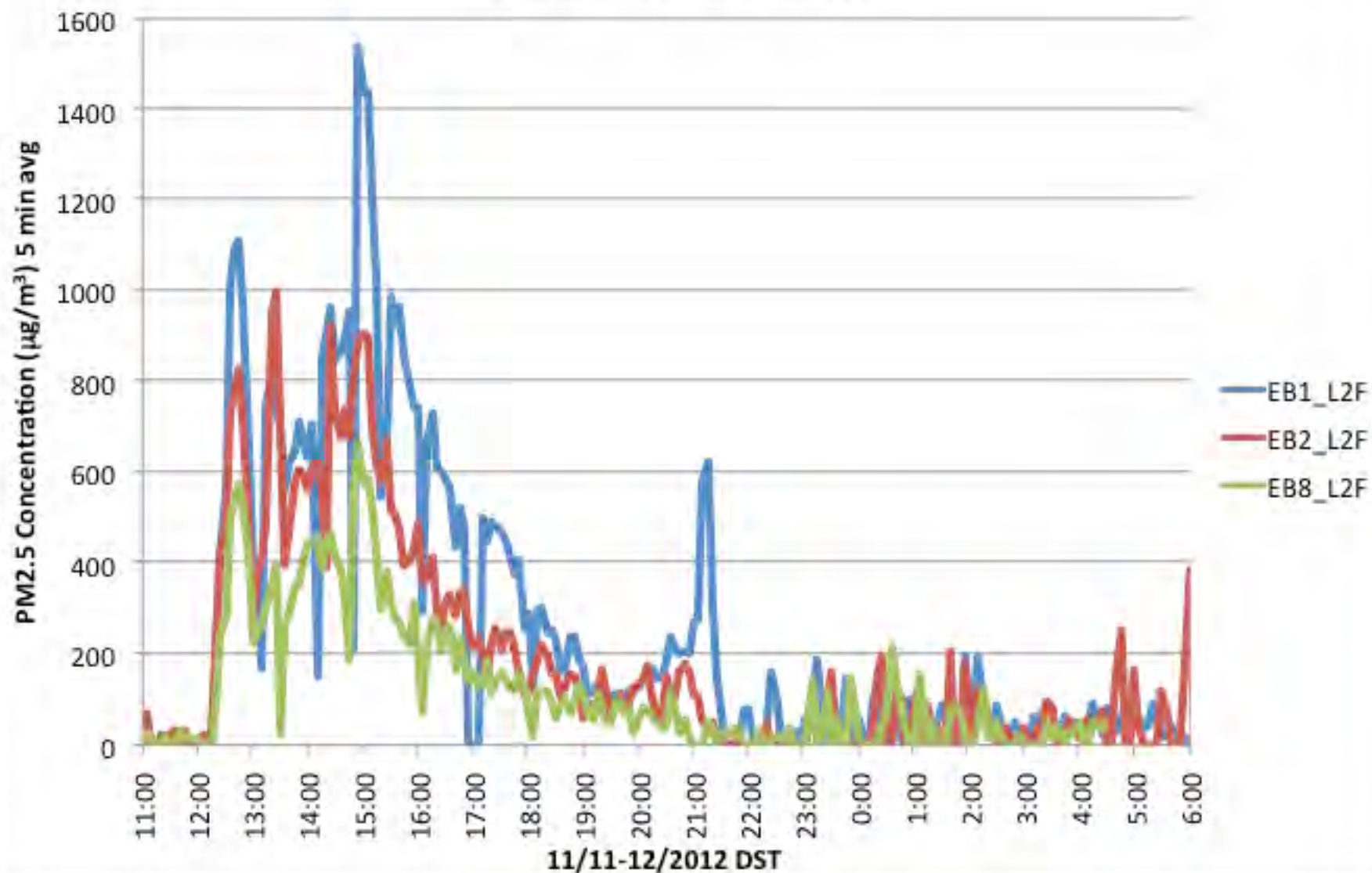
Eastern Line EBAM Data L1G

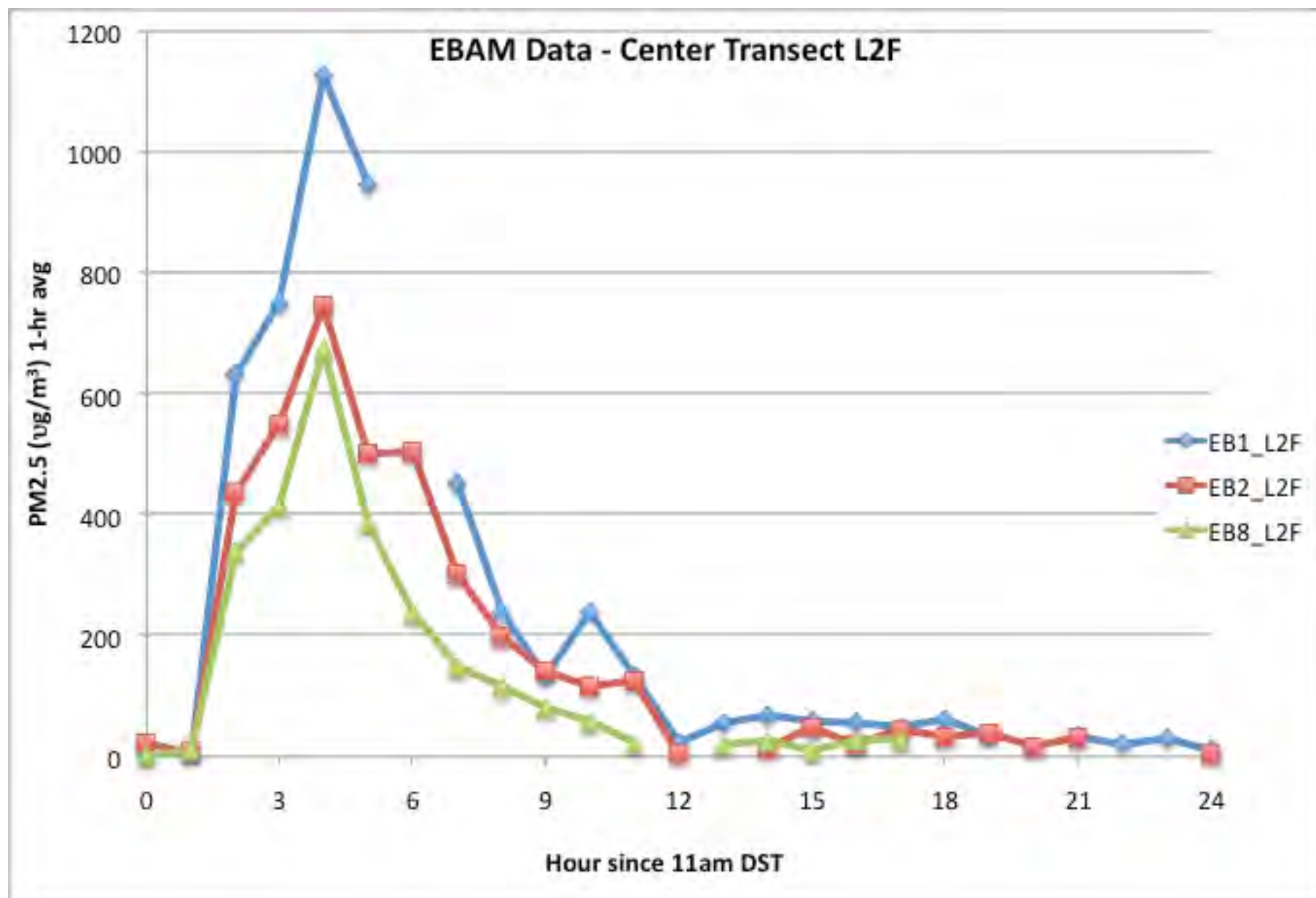


EBAM Data - Eastern Line L1G

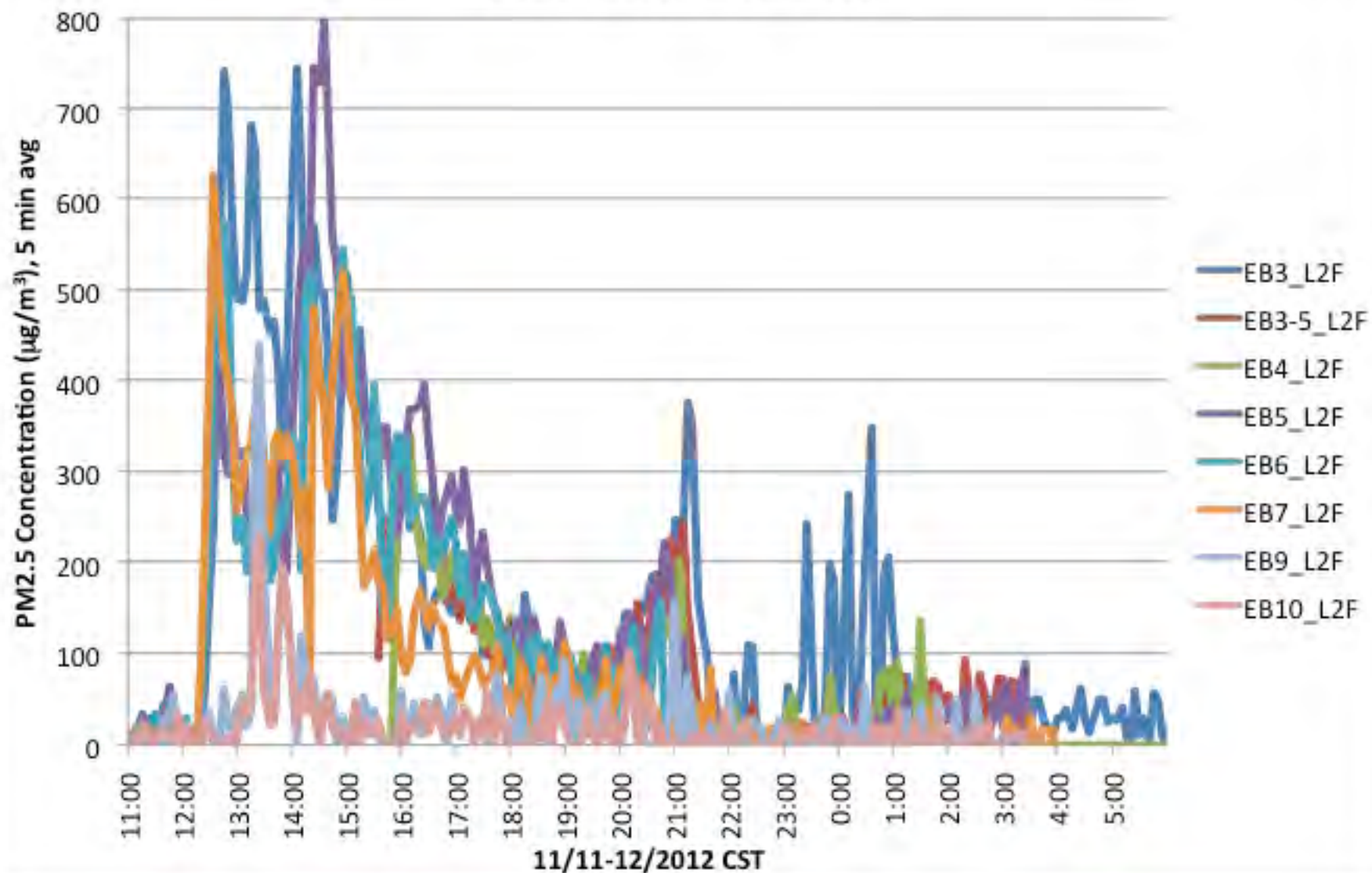


Centerline EBAM Data L2F

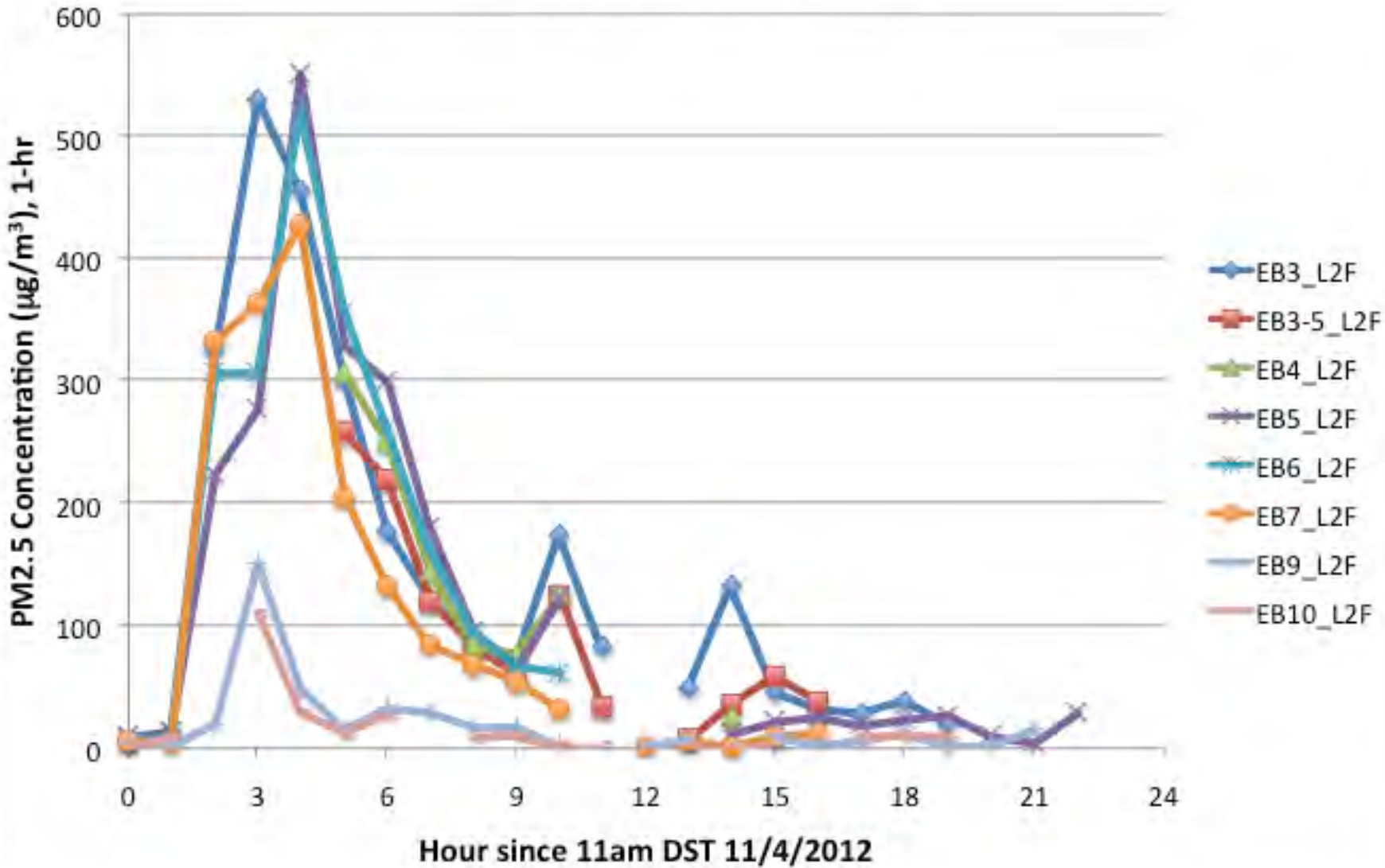




Crosswind EBAM Data L2F
